

## **SBLL Competition Committee 2022 – 2023**

The SBLL Competition Committee has been established to raise the level of play at Southbelt Little League by reviewing competitive aspects of the game, modifying/adopting rules and regulations, and to plan/execute initiatives for the benefit of the league and its' players.

On-field rules and regulations impact their preparation, performance, and ultimately, the integrity of the game itself. The committee's process for modifying or adopting rules and regulations will systematic and consensus-oriented and foremost in compliance with rules set by Little League International.

The committee's deliberative process will take into consideration the input of board members, coaches, players, parents, and other baseball related sources. The Competition Committee's actions will be based, in part, on feedback from a variety of sources.

The committee will meet as needed by conference call or in person to review current issues in the game and to begin to discuss potential agenda and action items.

The Competition Committee will also absorb responsibilities of the Playoff Committee (formerly chaired by ex-board member Aldo Salazar), which oversaw Post Season competitions and the All Star Selection process. The Post Season competitions include (and not limited to): End of Season Division Tournaments, District 15 Tournaments, SBLL Futures Games, All Star Tournament (ages 10 – 16).
